Yn dilyn ymweliad diweddar i Ysgol Friars ym Mangor, mae arolygwyr Estyn wedi dweud fod "newidiadau sylweddol" wedi bod i'r ysgol. Ymysg y llwyddiannau y cyfeirir atynt mae systemau diogelu a bugeiliol a'r pwyslais cryf ar ailadeiladu ymddiriedaeth a meithrin diwylliant cynhwysol.

Mae arweinyddiaeth yr ysgol a Chyngor Gwynedd wedi croesawu adroddiad yr arolygwyr addysg cenedlaethol ac wedi ymrwmo i gryfhau meysydd ble mae lle i wella.

'Nôl ym mis Chwefror, fel rhan o'r ymweliadau rheolaidd mae pob ysgol yng Nghymru yn eu cael, cynhaliwyd adolygiad manwl o safon yr addysgu a'r dysgu; lles, gofal, cymorth ac arweiniad o fewn yr ysgol; ac o drefniadau arwain a gwella.

Yn eu hadroddiad, mae'r adolygwyr yn nodi fod staff a llywodraethwyr yn ymroddgar; fod ymddygiad disgyblion yn dda; ac fod yr ysgol yn darparu amgylchedd ofalgar gyda darpariaeth ar gyfer anghenion emosiynol a dysgu disgyblion.

Cyfeiria'r adroddiad hefyd at y ffaith fod yr ysgol yn cynllunio cyfleoedd i ddisgyblion ddatblygu eu medrau Cymraeg ar draws y cwricwlwm.

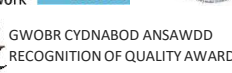
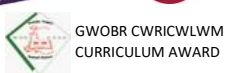
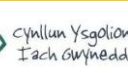

School looks to the future as it celebrates inspectors’ report

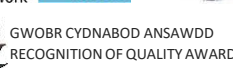
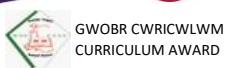
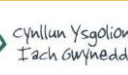
Following a recent visit to Ysgol Friars in Bangor, Estyn inspectors have said that there have been “significant changes” at the school. Among the successes referred to in the report are safeguarding and pastoral systems as well as the strong emphasis on rebuilding trust and fostering an inclusive culture.

The school’s leadership and Cyngor Gwynedd have welcomed the national education inspectors’ report and have committed to strengthening the areas where room for improvement has been identified.

Back in February, as part of the regular visits made to all schools in Wales, a detailed review was carried out of the quality of teaching and learning; wellbeing, care, support and guidance within the school; and leadership and improvement arrangements.

In their report, the inspectors note that staff and governors are dedicated; that pupils’ behaviour is good; and that the school provides a caring environment with provision for pupils’ emotional and learning needs.

The report also refers to the fact that the school plans opportunities for pupils to develop their Welsh-language skills across the curriculum.

The report also sets out recommendations to ensure that Ysgol Friars continues to thrive, and arrangements are already in place to incorporate these into the school's development plan.

Margaret Davies, Acting Headteacher of Ysgol Friars, said:

“We are very pleased with the findings of the report, which bear witness to the commitment and hard work of Ysgol Friars pupils and staff.

“Of course, there is always room for improvement, and the report identifies the areas where we need to continue to strengthen. We welcome these recommendations and are fully committed to addressing them thoroughly and effectively.”
